



Recognition of our cooperations partner BBA as UKTA issuing body

For suppliers who are currently marketing their products in Great Britain (England, Scotland, Wales) under an ETA (European Technical Assessments) will need an UKTA in future.

The UKTA (UK Technical Assessment) is the British equivalent of the ETA for non-harmonised products.

UKTAs can only be issued by technical assessment bodies located in Great Britain. Evaluated products can then be furnished with the UKCA label. Our cooperations partner British Board of Agrément is now the first recognised body for the issue of UKTAs in Great Britain.

As of now, the changeover from CE marking to UKCA marking must have taken place on January 1st, 2023 in order to continue to market products in Great Britain.
